### **Objectives & Rationale:**

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The Aquatic Ecosystem Health and Management Society (AEHMS) organizes international conferences every second year. The 8<sup>th</sup> AEHMS conference in Nanjing, will gather experts from across the world in the fields of aquatic ecosystem health, ecology, limnology, ecotoxicology, oceanography, conservation, restoration, modeling and socio-economics. This will enable participants to focus and exchange their views and experience on restoration and remediation of aquatic ecosystems. We hope the conference will be a focal point for the whole of the Asia Pacific region and especially China in exploring the tools, techniques and mechanisms of assessing ecosystem health.

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- ❖ Session 1: Environmental stressors of aquatic ecosystems and mechanism of ecosystem degradation
- ❖ Session 2: Techniques for restoration and remediation of aquatic ecosystem
- ❖ Session 3: Management of aquatic ecosystem
- ❖ Session 4: Assessment of Aquatic ecosystem health

### **Travel Information:**

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It is suggested that all participants who are not from China should arrive in Shanghai Pudong International Airport or Shanghai Hongqiao International Airport; the organizers will arrange for a bus from Shanghai and welcome all participants from abroad.

However, everyday there are several flights from Hong Kong, Beijing, Guangzhou, and Shenzhen to Nanjing. Below are listed some international flights of Nanjing Lukou International Airport.

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*Extended deadline for the abstracts: **October 15, 2005.***

English is the official conference language. All presentations, posters, and abstracts will be in English. Abstracts must be submitted by email to [lorimerj@dfo-mpo.gc.ca](mailto:lorimerj@dfo-mpo.gc.ca), as a Word file. WordPerfect or text files are also accepted. A message stating oral or poster presentation preference is to be enclosed with the abstract. Abstracts have a 300 word limit. Underline the presenting author and include affiliation, address and telephone/fax/email of the presenting author only. Abstracts should include objectives, methods, results, and conclusions. Authors will be notified of acceptance by **October 30, 2005**. Slide (35mm) and computer (PowerPoint) projection will be available, as will overhead projection. Authors using PowerPoint presentations should submit their presentations prior to the meeting to ensure compatibility.

### **AEHMS Publication Plans:**

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Selected manuscripts originating from the conference will be considered for publication subject to peer review in the journal: Aquatic Ecosystem Health and Management and/or Ecovision World Monograph Series. Instructions to author on the preparation of manuscripts can be found on the AEHMS website: [www.aehms.org](http://www.aehms.org).
